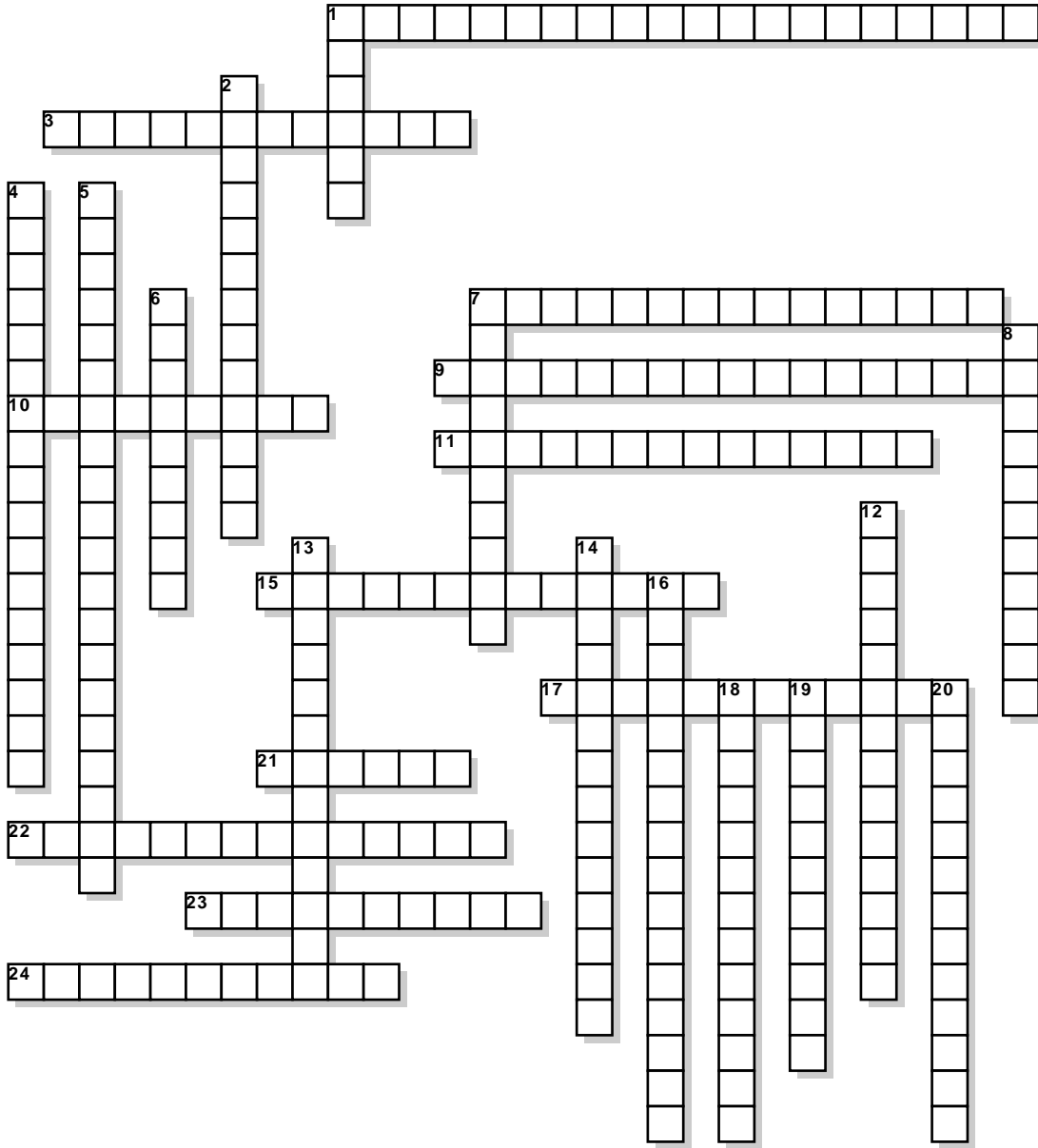


# Battle Of Gettysburg Crossword Puzzle



## Across

- 1 This saved Cemetery Ridge for the Union on the 2nd Day of battle.
- 3 Union General killed on July 1st by a confederate sniper. He commanded the left wing of the Union forces in charge of the I, III, and XI Corps.
- 7 General who commanded the Confederate First Corp
- 9 This saved Little Round Top for the Union at the end of the 2nd Day.
- 10 The principal land feature of the Union right flank, or "barbed" portion of what is described as the "fish-hook" line.
- 11 This New York General took command of the Union First Corps after the death of its leader, General Reynolds.
- 15 Roughly the Union center of what is popularly known as the "fish-hook" line.
- 17 One-armed Union General commanding the 11th Corp (after Reynolds was killed). He secured Cemetery Hill as the final Union position.
- 21 General who commanded the Confederate Third Corp
- 22 A Confederate infantry assault of nine Brigades (15,000 soldiers) on July 3rd that was a total failure. 50% casualties resulted.
- 23 Confederate General in Command
- 24 A boulder-strewn hill notable as the topographic high point of the Gettysburg Battlefield.

## Down

- 1 It was from here that General John Buford surveyed the battlefield on July 1st, 1863.
- 2 The site of Battle of Gettysburg fighting on July 1, 1863.
- 4 Colonel from Maine. Formerly a professor. He led the 20th Maine.
- 5 Union General 2nd Corp Commander. He was "Superb."
- 6 Confederate Cavalry Commander who didn't show up until late afternoon of July 2nd.
- 7 Union Major General who commanded the 1st Division Cavalry Corp.
- 8 Union General in Command
- 12 The Union Colonel of the 1st Minnesota Regiment.
- 13 Confederate Major General in Longstreet's 1st Corp. He played an important part in the disastrous confederate charge on the third day of battle.
- 14 The smaller of two rocky hills south of Gettysburg.
- 16 This Union General spotted Confederate forces moving around the Union left and toward Little Round Top. He rushed troops to the hill's defense.
- 18 General who commanded the Confederate Second Corp.
- 19 Robert E Lee called Longstreet this nickname
- 20 This Union Major General disobeyed Meade's orders and repositioned his men in Devil's Den, the Wheat Field, and the Peach Orchard.
